

Info Sheet for the 2012 6th Grade Disneyland Band Trip

REHEARSALS

Rehearsals for the 6th Grade Disneyland Band are **Wednesday February 29th and Thursday March 8th, from 3:20 to 4 pm**. Please be on time. The band will be recording on March 8th.

DISNEYLAND TRIP

The 6th Grade Disneyland Band Trip is **Saturday, March 10th**. Please be in the TPMS Band Room at **6:45 am**. Please do not be late.

Make sure you have everything you need: Music, Instrument (w/extra reeds), Jeans and TPMS Band polo shirt, snacks, sunscreen, cell phones, ipods, games, change of clothes (shorts if the weather is nice, sweatshirt for the evening), and money for food, lockers, or souvenirs.

We will start loading the buses at 7 am and must leave by 7:30 am. Every student is responsible for loading and unloading their own instrument. Percussionists are in charge of the percussion equipment that is assigned to them. Big instruments (tuba, trombone, percussion equipment, tenor sax, baritone sax, alto sax, trumpet, bass clarinet) will go underneath the buses. Clarinets, flutes, and oboes will go on the bus.

STUDENT RULES FOR THE TRIP

On the buses: Roll will be taken each time (buses will be assigned alphabetically by last name) we load the bus to leave a venue. Do not enter the bus until a chaperone has instructed you to do so. No screaming, yelling or walking while the bus is in motion. Please be respectful of the bus drivers and chaperones. Do not walk around in the bus while it is in motion. Food and drink are allowed on the buses, but please dispose of your trash in the trash bags that are provided.

All snacks will be shared with Mr. Moreau.

At the Performance Site: We need to arrive at the performance site (**Lakeview Elementary School, 17510 Lakeview Avenue Yorba Linda, CA 92886**) by 9:20 am. Please do not get off the buses until instructed to do so. Make sure you have everything you need to perform with you when you leave the bus. Do not play or talk loudly when our guides lead us to the warm up room. Remember you are guests at the school, representing Twin Peaks Middle School and being watched by the judges. Listen and follow instructions. The rehearsal room might be small or not ideal, but we will do the best we can and if you have a problem or question please raise your hand so we can help you. We will enter the stage quietly single file and leave quietly single file.

The band will warm up at 9:50 am and perform at 10:20 am. Parents are welcome to attend.

After the performance, we will either load the buses quickly or stay in our seats for the award ceremony. Roll will be taken when we leave for Disneyland. It is approximately a 25 minute bus ride to Disneyland from the school.

At Disneyland. When we get to Disneyland take everything with you that you will need for the day because you will not be able to go back to the buses until the end of the evening. All students will be in a group of 12-16 (students will pick the groups) with a chaperone. Students will need to follow the directions of their chaperone and stay with your group at all times. Your TPMS Band Polo Shirt is to be worn at all times, you are **representing** Twin Peaks Middle School so your behavior needs to be at its best. All rules of TPMS still apply. No cutting in lines and be respectful to all employees. Do not leave the park. Be on time, **the buses will leave at 10 pm sharp**, we do not want to be charged overtime. If you are feeling sick, my cell number will given to all chaperones and in the First Aid room as well. First Aid will have my cell number so you can contact them in case of emergencies

First Aid is located at the end of Main Street, U.S.A., across from the Central Plaza next to the Baby Center.

Parents please write me a note if you are going to take your son or daughter home separately. Parents may only take home their own child.

Parents are more than welcome to come to the concert and go to Disneyland. At the concert, they sell Disneyland tickets at a reduced price.
